Dear Residence Hall Students and Staff,

As you know, the Residence Hall Awards Ceremony, The Golden Joes, is on **Saturday, April 21st**, tentatively scheduled for **7:00pm**. This ceremony is a time when we recognize those in the Residence Halls, who have demonstrated outstanding leadership and service throughout the year. In order to determine whom to recognize, we need you to submit nominations for the awards.

Remember that the purpose of these awards are to recognize those who have been leaders and those who have served the students in their hall communities this year. Every hall has outstanding people living in that community who deserve to be recognized for their efforts. One person should not have to write all the nominations for your hall. At the **absolute minimum** every hall should be able to nominate at least one person for First Year Student of the Year, Man and Woman of the Year, People's Choice for Outstanding RA, and Program of the Year. The challenge is to nominate someone for every award.

Attached are the criteria for the individual award and two copies of the nomination form. If additional nomination forms are needed please feel free to make copies. If you have any questions please contact Sam Koester at samk@uidaho.edu.

EXECUTIVE OF THE YEAR

The Executive Officer is an invaluable member of the teams that drive success in the residence halls. This award recognizes an Executive Officer who has been instrumental in leading his/her hall or RHA through a successful year.

Eligibility:

This award is available to all students who have lived in the Residence Halls during the 2011–2012 year **and** who have served as an officer on any executive board in RHA for at least one semester during the year.

Selection Criteria:

The nominees will be evaluated on the following criteria (the comments under each criterion are simply guidelines and not necessarily specific questions to answer):

- 🏆 **Hall Involvement and Leadership** – impact this person has had on the hall; how has this person stood out as a leader; has this person been a positive role model for all residents; created any new programs or traditions for the hall; instituted positive change in the hall and overcome obstacles; have motivated residents and executive board
- 🏆 **Residence Hall Leadership** – impact this person had on the residence hall community as a whole; active in RHA beyond weekly meetings; helped with any residence hall wide events
- 🏆 **Academics** – member of any Honorariums; is the nominee's GPA especially high; made the Dean's List, received any scholarships, etc.
- 🏆 **Campus Involvement** – involved in any campus clubs, organizations, and/or activities; impact on campus community
- 🏆 **Honors and Awards** – other honors and awards the nominee has received
- 🏆 **Other Exceptional Qualifications** – what makes the nominee stand out; why is this person an outstanding role model to other RHA officers and residence hall students

One award is available. Nominees will be solicited from Residence Hall students and staff. Self-nominations are also accepted. The nominee or nominator must fill out the awards nomination form included in this packet.
