Dear Residence Hall Students and Staff,

As you know, the Residence Hall Awards Ceremony, The Golden Joes, is on **Saturday, April 21<sup>st</sup>**, tentatively scheduled for **7:00pm**. This ceremony is a time when we recognize those in the Residence Halls, who have demonstrated outstanding leadership and service throughout the year. In order to determine whom to recognize, we need you to submit nominations for the awards.

Remember that the purpose of these awards are to recognize those who have been leaders and those who have served the students in their hall communities this year. Every hall has outstanding people living in that community who deserve to be recognized for their efforts. One person should not have to write all the nominations for your hall. At the **absolute minimum** every hall should be able to nominate at least one person for First Year Student of the Year, Man and Woman of the Year, People's Choice for Outstanding RA, and Program of the Year. The challenge is to nominate someone for every award.

# FIRST YEAR STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award is given to someone who has been actively involved in their hall and who, as a first year student, has made a positive impact on the hall community.

## Eligibility:

This award is available to all students (undergraduate and graduate) who are in his/her first year in the Residence Halls during the 2011-2012 year.

## Selection Criteria:

The nominees will be evaluated on the following criteria (the comments under each criterion are simply guidelines and not necessarily specific questions to answer),

- 🏆 **Hall Involvement and Leadership** – involved and participated in the hall; held any offices or other leadership positions in the residence halls; any conferences attended or programs presented; has this person helped their hall community or the residence halls as a whole grow and develop; what activities and events has this person participated in
- 🏆 **Academics** – member of any Honorariums; is the nominee's GPA especially high; made the Dean's List, received any scholarships, etc.
- 🏆 **Campus Involvement** – involved in any campus clubs, organizations, and/or activities; leadership positions held
- 🏆 **Honors and Awards** – other honors and awards the nominee has received
- 🏆 **Other Exceptional Qualifications** – what makes the nominee stand out; why is this person an outstanding role model to other residence hall students

Please do not include high school information

Two awards are available, one male and one female. Nominees will be solicited from Residence Hall students and staff. Self-nominations are also accepted. The nominee or nominator must fill out the awards nomination form included in this packet.
