Dear Residence Hall Students and Staff,

As you know, the Residence Hall Awards Ceremony, The Golden Joes, is on **Saturday, April 21st**, tentatively scheduled for **7:00pm**. This ceremony is a time when we recognize those in the Residence Halls, who have demonstrated outstanding leadership and service throughout the year. In order to determine whom to recognize, we need you to submit nominations for the awards.

Remember that the purpose of these awards are to recognize those who have been leaders and those who have served the students in their hall communities this year. Every hall has outstanding people living in that community who deserve to be recognized for their efforts. One person should not have to write all the nominations for your hall. At the **absolute minimum** every hall should be able to nominate at least one person for First Year Student of the Year, Man and Woman of the Year, People's Choice for Outstanding RA, and Program of the Year. The challenge is to nominate someone for every award.

INDIVIDUAL COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

This is an award to recognize individuals who have shown outstanding commitment and dedication to serving the community during the 2011–2012 year. A person should be nominated for this award based on initiative they have shown for voluntary service to the community. Nominations should not be based on work done for compensation or academic credit and should only focus on work done this year.

Eligibility:

This award is available to all students (undergraduate and graduate) who have lived in the Residence Halls during the 2011–2012 year.

Selection Criteria:

The nominees will be evaluated on the following criteria (these are simply guidelines and not necessarily specific questions to answer):

- 🏆 What are the events or circumstances that motivated the nominee to take service action?
- 🏆 What kind of community service work has this person done?
- 🏆 Does this person work heavily with one group or cause, or does he/she work a little with several groups or causes?
- 🏆 Has this person been an organizer of community service efforts?
- 🏆 What has been the impact of this person's service?
- 🏆 Who has benefited?

Please do not include High-School info

One award is available. Nominees will be solicited from Residence Hall students and staff. Self-nominations are also accepted. The nominee or nominator must fill out the awards nomination form included in this packet.
